JUDGES LIST REQUIREMENTS: JANUARY 2010

A1 SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges who have been previously approved to award Challenge Certificates in the

Kooikerhondje breed and have carried out the appointment

REQUIREMENTS: Not applicable as the breed does not have CC status at present

A1 NON-SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges who have been previously approved to award Challenge Certificates in the

Kooikerhondje breed and have carried out the appointment

REQUIREMENTS: Not applicable as the breed does not have CC status at present

A2 SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges, who if invited to judge by the Kooikerhondje Club of Great Britain, would in principle be approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the Kooikerhondje breed for that occasion. **REQUIREMENTS:** Not applicable as the breed does not have CC status at present

A2 NON-SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges, who if invited to judge by the Kooikerhondje Club of Great Britain, would in principle be approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the Kooikerhondje breed for that occasion REQUIREMENTS: Not applicable as the breed does not have CC status at present

A3 SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges who are recommended by the Kooikerhondje Club of Great Britain as being suitable to award Challenge Certificates in the Kooikerhondje breed, but not yet approved by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 list

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 Minimum of **7 years** judging experience in the Kooikerhondje breed and have the support of the Club (KC policy) AND
- To have judged at a Club Show or the breed at **4** Open shows or Championship shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread AND
- To have judged at least **20** Kooikerhondje present AND
- 4 [From July 2001] To have attended:
 - a. a seminar given by a KC accredited trainer and passed an exam on KC regulations and judging procedures (KC policy) AND
 - b. a seminar on conformation and movement AND
 - c. a KC Hands-on assessment AND passed the assessment
 - d. a Kooikerhondje- breed specific seminar AND passed the subsequent examination
- To have bred and/or owned a minimum of **3** dogs when they obtained their first entry into the KC Stud book [save in exceptional circumstances] AND
- To have stewarded over a period of a minimum of 3 years and at least 12 shows

A3 NON-SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges who are recommended by the Kooikerhondje Club of Great Britain as being suitable to award Challenge Certificates in the Kooikerhondje breed, but not yet approved by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 list

REQUIREMENTS:

- To be approved by the Kennel Club to judge Best in Show and/or Groups at championships shows OR
- To be approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in one or more of the gundog breeds OR
- 3 To have:
 - a. a minimum of 7 years judging experience in one breed to include 5 years in the Kooikerhondje breed and have the support of the Club (KC policy) AND
 - b. To have judged a minimum of 30 dogs of the Kooikerhondje breed present AND
- To have attended:
 - a. a seminar given by a KC accredited trainer and passed an exam on KC regulations and judging procedures (KC policy) AND
 - b. a seminar on conformation and movement AND
 - c. a KC Hands-on assessment AND passed the assessment
 - d. a Kooikerhondje- breed specific seminar AND passed the subsequent examination

B LIST SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges with a specialist interest in the breed that the Club would support to judge the Kooikerhondje without CCs or at all open shows **REQUIREMENTS:**

- To have a minimum of 2 years experience of judging the Kooikerhondje breed and have the support of the 1
- To have judged at least 15 Kooikerhondje present in a minimum of 5 classes at shows spread over a wide 2 area AND
- 3 To have attended a Kooikerhondje- breed specific seminar AND passed the subsequent examination AND
- 4 To have some stewarding experience

B LIST NON-SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Judges whom the Club would support to judge the Kooikerhondje without CCs or at all open shows

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 To have a minimum of 2 years experience and involvement in any one breed and have the support of the Club AND
- 2 To have judged at least 15 Kooikerhondie present in a minimum of 5 classes at shows spread over a wide area OR To have attended a Kooikerhondje- breed specific seminar AND passed the subsequent examination AND
- Preferably have some stewarding experience

This list will normally include persons who have judged the breed but do not qualify for any of the other lists

C LISTS SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Aspirant judges with a specialist interest in he breed whom the Club would support to judge the Kooikerhondie at open shows

REQUIREMENTS:

- To have a minimum of 2 years experience and involvement in any one breed and have the support of the 1
- 2 To have attended a Kooikerhondje-breed specific seminar AND
- 3 Preferably have some stewarding experience.

C LIST NON-SPECIALISTS

DEFINITION: Aspirant judges whom the Club would support to judge the Kooikerhondje at open shows who do not yet fall into any of the above categories

REQUIREMENTS:

To have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the Club
